Feed the Hungry & Give Drink to the Thirsty

Whoever has a bountiful eye will be blessed, for he shares his bread with the poor (Proverbs 22:9).

When we look outside of our "comfort zone", our familiar routine we see that matters are more drastic in other parts of the world. Pope Benedict XVI has written that feeding the hungry is an ethical imperative for the universal Church, and he observes: "Hunger is not so much dependent on lack of material things as on a shortage of social resources" (*Caritas in veritate* 27). We all will thirst for the love of our neighbour, the love of our parents, our family members, indeed for the love and attention of all our friends. Saint Therese of Lisieux invites us to practice the little way of love, not to miss out on a kind word, a smile or any small gesture which sows peace and friendship.
