We want your old unused bikes! We are Transition Year students at Coláiste Pobail Bheanntraí. As part of our religion class we have decided to do a charity project for the coming year. In many of our garden sheds there are good bikes no longer being used. We want to put them to good use.

In many parts of Africa, they have no cars and their only transport is either walking or cycling. Many young people have to walk many kilometres to their local schools. We are going to collect bikes from our local community which are no longer being used. Our plan is to clean and repair these bikes up into their former selves. Our bikes are going to be sent to the charity Re-Cycle in England and they will send the bikes to Africa for us. We are getting help from our school chaplain, Father James, who is a keen cyclist and cycle mechanic himself. He has already trained us in the basics of bike repair.

This is where we need your help. We are asking you to donate your unused bikes to us, so we can clean, repair and refurbish your bike. We are looking for bikes in reasonably good repair. Racing bikes are not suitable because of the rough terrain in Africa. Also small children's bikes are not suitable. The ideal bikes for us are Mountain Bikes and Hybrid Bikes.
